2018 CASEA PROGRAM



We have had a fantastic start to the year! On Monday all staff participated in a whole day of professional learning with the CASEA team. We learnt about challenging behaviours, the risk and protective factors that affect a child's

behaviour. We also learnt about preventative behaviour management strategies. We are very excited to begin our partnership with CASEA.

Our partnership with CASEA is not just between the school and CASEA but also with the SJB families. Yesterday all Prep-Year 3 students received a pack from CASEA. This included, an information brochure, Record of Consent Form and a Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire. We ask families to return the consent form and questionnaire to your child's teacher by Thursday 8th February.

For those who may have missed our introduction to CASEA in last year's newsletter please find the information below.

We are very excited to announce that St John Bosco's has invited the CAMHS and Schools: Early Action Program (CASEA) to be part of the school community for term 1 and 2 in 2018.

The CASEA Program is an Early Intervention service for young children (Prep to Year 3) who present with challenging behaviours. CASEA is a program developed by The Royal Children's Hospital Integrated Mental Health Program and funded by the Mental Health Branch of the Department of Human Services.

The program offers:

• A universal behavioural screen for all children in Grades Prep-3

• Professional development seminars for all teachers and school staff

Classroom behavioural activities for Grades Prep-3 children

Group programs for selected children and parents

This program will be run by Rebecca Sobell (Psychologist) and Leanne Pethick (Psychologist) from The Royal Children's Hospital.

All application forms need to be endorsed by the school and we are only allowed to endorse 3 girls and boys per sport.

ST. JOHN BOSCO'S SCHOOL CHESS CLUB – TERM 1, 2018

Chess is one of the most powerful educational tools available to strengthen a child's mind. Most 6-7 year olds can follow the basic rules and some children as young as 4 or 5 can play. Whatever a child's age, chess can enhance concentration, patience, and perseverance, as well as develop creativity, intuition, and memory. Most importantly, children can develop the ability to analyse and deduce from a set of general principles, to make tough decisions and to solve problems flexibly.

The coaches, David Beaumont and Phil Dragic are experienced chess teachers and two of Victoria's leading chess players.

The chess classes will take the children through a structured chess course with the dual aim of achieving the maximal educational benefits the game offers and providing an enjoyable learning environment.

CSEF ELIGIBILITY

Below is the criteria used to determine a student's eligibility for the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF).

Criteria 1 - Eligibility

To be eligible" for the fund, a parent or legal guardian of a student attending a registered Government or nongovernment Victorian primary or secondary school must:

- on the first day of Term one, or,
- on the first day of Term two;
 - a) Be an eligible beneficiary within the meaning of the State Concessions Act 2004, that is, be a holder of Veterans Affairs Gold Card or be an eligible Centrelink Health Care Card (HCC) or Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) holder. OR
 - b) Be a temporary foster parent, and;
 - c) Submit an application to the school by the due date.

* A special consideration eligibility category also exists. For more information, see: www.education.vic.gov.au/csef

Parents who receive a Carer Allowance on behalf of a child, or any other benefit or allowance not income tested by Centrelink, are not eligible for the CSEF unless they also comply with one of (a) or (b) above.

Criteria 2 - Be of school age and attend school in Victoria

School is compulsory for all Victorian children aged between six and 17 years of age inclusive.

For the purposes of CSEF, students may be eligible for assistance if they attend a Victorian registered primary or secondary school. Typically, these students are aged between five and 18 years inclusive.

CSEF is not payable to students attending pre-school, kindergarten, home schooled, or TAFE.

Eligibility Date

For concession card holders CSEF eligibility will be subject to the parent/legal guardian's concession card being successfully validated with Centrelink on the first day of either term one (29 January 2018) or term two (16 April 2018).

PAYMENT AMOUNTS

CSEF payment amount

The CSEF is an annual payment to the school to be used towards camps, sports and/or excursion expenses for the benefit of the eligible student.

- Primary school student rate: \$125 per year.
- Secondary school student rate: \$225 per year.

The CSEF is paid directly to your child's school and will be allocated by the school towards camps, sports and/or excursion costs for your child.

For ungraded students, the rate payable is determined by the student's date of birth. For more information, see: www.education.vic.gov.au/csef

Year 7 government school students who are CSEF recipients are also eligible for a uniform voucher. Secondary schools are required to make applications on behalf of parents so please register your interest at the school.
