Seasons Program 2018 – Peer Support for Grief and Loss

We will be looking to start our 2018 Seasons Program soon. The Seasons Program is a peer support group for children who have experienced grief and loss in their lives and wish to work through their feelings and ask those commonly asked questions about their experience. Common reasons for taking part in the program include the death of a loved one, family separation or divorce. The group will meet for 10 sessions and each will be facilitated by myself or Sommer Azzopardi. Students are supported throughout the program by the teacher and their peers as they share their stories, ask questions and listen to each other. If you think this program would suit your child or children could you please email myself or Sommer, including the reason for participating. Once groups are sorted you will be contacted and given further information regarding session days and times.




