### NEW ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

From the beginning of Term 3, all Victorian schools are required to contact parents/carers as soon as practicable on the same day of an unexplained student absence. If your child is absent on a particular day and you have not contacted the school to explain why, the absence will be marked as unexplained.

In this circumstance SJB will take the following steps:

1. If your child has been marked on the roll as **\*absent** you will receive a text message at 9.15am saying "Your child has been marked on the roll as absent. Please respond via SMS with an explanation for your child's absence. e.g Sarah from 2ET is away today because she is sick.

**\*absent** = students who are away from school without an explanation. This **does not include absences with an explanation** e.g. holidays, medical appointments, advising the teacher prior to the day of absence etc),

2. If we do not hear back from you via SMS by 9.30am, the school will contact you.

It is important to let teachers know if your child is going to be away from school as soon as possible, especially for planned absences.

There may be times in which you have advised the teacher that morning via email but if the teacher is also absent, you will receive an SMS.
