NEW ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

From the beginning of Term 3, all Victorian schools are required to contact parents/carers as soon as practicable on the same day of an unexplained student absence.

If your child is absent and you have not contacted the school to explain why, the absence will be marked as unexplained. In this circumstance SJB will take the following steps:

1. If your child has been marked on the roll as **absent** without an explanation you will receive a text message at 9.15am saying "Your child has been marked on the role as absent.
2. Parents are asked to respond via SMS with an explanation for your child's absence. e.g Sarah from 2ET is away today because she is sick.
3. If we do not receive a response via SMS by 9.30am, the school will contact you.

How to notify a student absence

Notification should be made to your child's teacher on the morning or before the day of the absence. **This must be made in writing via email, note or completion of the SJB Student Absence Form** (available from the office notice board).
