PRINCIPAL NEWS

St John Bosco's uniform policy has been raised with me by children and parents over the last few weeks. It has been brought to my attention that some of our children feel restricted by the uniform as it hinders their ability to play. Our children need to be able to play with freedom in order to relax and refresh after hard sessions in the classroom. While our uniform will not change, all children will be able to wear all options of the current school uniform. However this is not a 'pick and choose' opportunity. So if a girl decides she would feel better equipped for the yard by wearing long or short pants then as long as they are grey and the shirt and tie (winter) or the blue shirt (summer) is worn, then they will be deemed to be in their correct uniform. I hope these arrangements make all children comfortable within their school environment.

All parents are asked to visit our Parent Code of Conduct and Complaints Handling Procedure under the School-Policies heading on our website. These policies spell out the expected behaviour of parents with regard to conversing with children and teachers alike and what to do if you have a grievance. These policies are designed to further enhance the communication process within the school.

Yesterday 150 families received a copy of a questionnaire about the daily running of the school. These families were chosen randomly, by selecting every second family from our alphabetical family list
