Parents are reminded that any concerns you have about your children and their peers need to be dealt with by the teachers or myself. Our Parent Code of Conduct and our School Community Child Safety Code of Conduct are very explicit about the need for adults to refrain from reprimanding another person's child.

All families are asked to complete the Catholic School Identity project online questionnaire by the end of term. Instructions can be found on all seesaw pages. This survey will be used extensively within our school review framework in 2019.

On Monday the children in Grades 3 and 5 received their NAPLAN results. Please remember these results are indicative of your child's understanding for a 40 minute time frame every 2 to 3 years. If they cover only a two year cycle they are trying to assess in 40 minutes, the curriculum that has been covered over 80 weeks, 400 days or 2000 hours of schooling. Your child's reports are based on 6 months, 20 weeks, 100 days or 500 hours of learning. Nothing compares to a teacher who knows your child's strengths and weaknesses and how they learn and test best.




School Oval Upgrade -Community Use
