SCHOOL FETE VOLUNTEERS



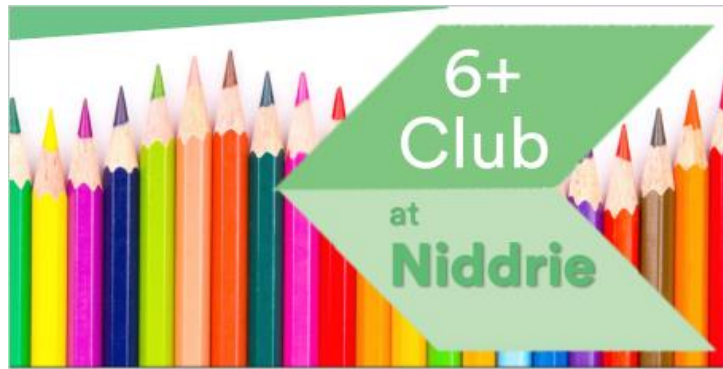
