On Tuesday I met with Adam Taylor, Principal of St Bernard's College, to discuss the applications for Year 7 in 2021. We spoke about the 28 boys who have applied from St John Bosco's, each of whom I think is worthy applicant. Adam informed me that he has 335 applications with only 285 places available in Year 7. One of several criteria for placement at St Bernard's is engagement in the parish ministry.

Father's/Special Person's Day BBQ


