Hiring Staff and Staff Training

Our principal and deputy principals evaluate all new staff members closely before they hire them by:

- making sure they have a Working With Children Check
- talking to the people they have worked with in the past and asking them specific questions about how they treat children

New staff also sign the Code of Conduct and have training to make sure they know about keeping children safe at SJB.

SJB adults have to make sure that kids feel safe and speak up.
