## St John Bosco's internal school process for mandatory reporting

Melbourne Archdiocese Catholic Schools (MACS) schools should develop internal procedures consistent with PROTECT and the Four Critical Actions referenced in the Policy. Schools may document these internal procedures below in a variety of ways, including a flow chart. The internal procedures must be readily available to all members of the school community, including on the public website.

## FOUR CRITICAL ACTIONS FOR SCHOOLS

Responding to Incidents, Disclosures and Suspicions of Child Abuse

YOU MUST TAKE ACTION • You must act, by following the Four Critical Actions, as soon as you witness an incident, receive a disclosure or form a reasonable belief " that a child has, or is at risk of being abused.

As a school staff member, you play a **critical role** in p You **must** act if you form a suspicion/ reasonable belief, even if you are unsure and have not directly observed child abuse (e.g. if the victim or another person relis you about the base). Y

 It is strongly recommended that you use the Responding to Suspected Child Abuse template to keep clear and comprehensive notes, even if you make a decision not to report.
